



**General Notes:**

1. Contractor must provide access to GLWA staff to all structures, valves, lagoons, and free passage of personnel and vehicles from the plant to the lagoons at all times.
2. Contractor must stage all vehicles, equipment, staging, washdown, drying, processing, loading, temporary office, parking and other operations within the designated Contractor Work Area. No trucks or equipment will be allowed to park within the main plant fenceline.
3. Contractor shall prevent the tracking of mud or sludge onto the plant access road and keep the plant access road and Metcalf Road clean and free of dirt and dust from Contractor's work.
