WHEREAS, 2022 marks the 85th Anniversary of the National Apprenticeship Act; and

WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) recognizes the urgent need to prepare and maintain an inclusive, diverse and highly-skilled workforce that is capable of meeting the demands of the water services sector and the Michigan communities and residents served by GLWA; and
