



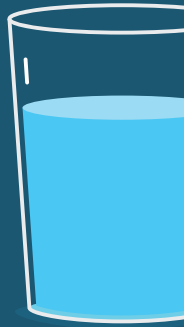

Water Residential Assistance Program



WHAT IS WRAP?

WRAP provides income-based assistance to eligible households who receive water and/or sewer service from GLWA via member partner communities. Households can receive assistance with paying down past due balances and receive water and sewer bill payment assistance for up to two years. Eligible seniors and disabled persons can obtain bill credit assistance, without an expiration date. Participants may also receive conservation assistance and minor plumbing repairs.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Households are eligible for WRAP if they meet the following criteria:

- Reside within the GLWA service area
- Demonstrate household income at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty level
- Establish they are responsible for the water or sewer bill
- Reside in the home they own or rent
