

MEDIA SEVERE WEATHER ALERT UPDATE – June 18, 2025

GLWA Chief Operating Officer, Wastewater Operating Services, Navid Mehran:

GLWA wants to alert the community, especially those in low lying areas and those who have previously experienced flooding, that the U.S. National Weather Service is predicting severe storms with possible local heavy rainfall over the next 12 hours. Total rainfall is predicted to be 1.5–2.0 inches across the region.

The predicted rainfall is within the design capacity of the regional system. While the regional conveyance system is currently receiving rainfall, the system is operating as designed.

GLWA is asking residents in low-lying areas that are prone to flooding during heavy rainfall to remain vigilant and out of an abundance of caution, to remove items of value from their basements.
