

MEDIA SEVERE WEATHER ALERT UPDATE – June 30, 2025

GLWA Chief Operating Officer, Wastewater Operating Services, Navid Mehram:

GLWA wants to alert the community, especially those in low lying areas and those who have previously experienced flooding, that the U.S. National Weather Service is predicting severe storms with possible local heavy rainfall over the next several hours. Total rainfall is predicted to be up to 2.0 inches across the region.

The predicted rainfall is within the design capacity of the regional system, and the regional conveyance system is currently in dry conditions and operating as designed.

GLWA is asking residents in low-lying areas that are prone to flooding during heavy rainfall to remain vigilant and out of an abundance of caution, to remove items of value from their basements.
