

42-inch Inkster Road Transmission Main Loop Project

Project Description:

- The Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) is installing a new 42-inch diameter water transmission main along Inkster Road from Pennsylvania Road to Wick Road.
- This new water main will create a loop in the regional water system to lower the risk of future water service interruptions.
- The loop will be created by connecting the existing 48-inch diameter water transmission main at the intersection of Wick Road and Inkster Road to the existing 30-inch transmission main at the intersection of Inkster Road and Pennsylvania Road, via the new four mile long, 42-inch transmission main along Inkster Road.
- Construction of the project is expected to begin in spring 2026 and be completed in 2028.
- GLWA is coordinating closely with the City of Romulus, the City of Taylor, and Wayne County Department of Public Services as the project progresses.

Construction Impacts:

- Residents and businesses along Inkster Road from Pennsylvania Road to Wick Road will be impacted by this work, as well those that typically pass through this area.
- Intermittent road closures will be necessary, with local traffic being maintained throughout the project.
- Driveway access may be temporarily limited for up to 8 hours. Residents and businesses impacted will be notified at least 24 hours in advance.
- Project phases and a detailed schedule will be shared closer to the start of construction.
