

MEDIA SEVERE WEATHER ALERT UPDATE – March 31, 2026

GLWA Chief Operating Officer, Wastewater Operating Services, Navid Mehram:

GLWA wants to alert the community, especially those in low lying areas and those who have previously experienced flooding, that the U.S. National Weather Service is predicting severe storms with possible local heavy rainfall this week. The total rainfall is predicted to be 1.4 inches in the local region.

The predicted rainfall is within the design capacity of the regional system, which is fully dewatered from the morning's wet weather. In anticipation of the approaching large storm event, GLWA is closely monitoring conditions, and the wastewater conveyance team is monitoring to ensure that all systems remain at the ready to respond.

GLWA is asking residents in low-lying areas that are prone to flooding during heavy rainfall to remain vigilant and out of an abundance of caution, to remove items of value from their basements.
