Valve Inspections - Potential Temporary Impact to Drinking Water Appearance

The Detroit Water & Sewerage Department (DWSD) and Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) will be opening and closing water main valves in your area during the week of September 14. There is currently no expected impact, but at times, this type of work may cause a temporary change in the appearance of your drinking water.

During the week of September 14, if you observe cloudy water coming out of the faucets in your home, please call or email the Detroit Water & Sewerage Department (DWSD) at 313-267-8000 or dwsd-publicaffairs@detroitmi.gov with your name, address and phone number. DWSD will respond immediately and flush the water main on your street to resolve the cloudy water.

This work is not expected to cause water service interruptions. Any changes in appearance of the drinking water are temporary but we still ask that you notify us immediately so we take all steps to resolve the issue as soon as possible.
